Term	Definition
Accreditation	The action or process of officially recognizing as having a particular status or being qualified to perform a particular activity.
Act	Is legislation passed by Congress and signed by the president.
Amendment	An addition or alteration to a bill, resolution, statute, or law.
Audit	An examination performed by an independent third party that verifies the guidelines outlined by a regulatory body.
Bill	A legislative proposal of a general nature. A bill may address either a public or private matter. Before an act is passed it is called a bill.
Certificate	A document attesting a level of achievement in a course of study or training.
Certification/Certified	Certifications are issued by a non-governmental certification body and convey that an individual has the knowledge or skill to perform a specific job.
Code	A systematic collection of laws or regulations.
Compliance	Compliance is being in accordance with established guidelines or specifications.
Compliance Audit	A compliance audit is a comprehensive review of an organization's adherence to regulatory guidelines.
Ethics	The decisions, choices, and actions we make that reflect and enact our values.
Law	A rule or regulations established by a governing body.
Licensure/Licensed	An occupational license issued by a state regulatory board or government agency that permits a person to legally practice an occupation.
Registration/Registered	Any person who has received special training or education in a field and holds and is required by law to hold, a valid license to practice in the relevant specialty.
Regulation	A rule or directive made and maintained by an authority.
Regulatory Compliance	Regulatory compliance is an organization's adherence to laws, regulations, guidelines, and specifications relevant to its business.
Standard	Established by authority, custom or general consent as a model or example; something set up and established by authority as a rule for the measure of quantity, weight, extent, value, or quality.
